

Taplow Parish Council raises concerns about the situation at Cliveden Stud

SBDC Planning recently rejected an application at Cliveden Stud (ref PL/19/0774/EU) based on a claimed breach of planning permission for more than ten years. This was very much the correct decision but highlights the continuing and clearly deliberate flouting of planning law on this site.

Even since this latest ruling there are new flagrant breaches of planning on the site with the erection of buildings with no planning approval.

You dealt with residencies on the site being occupied in breach of conditions but they are again occupied, almost certainly in breach.

There have been countless other breaches in recent years.

In the light of what is a sustained assault of breaches of planning law, apparently in an attempt to run the site down to destruction of viability, it is essential that SBDC clearly articulate how they intend to combat this to preserve the amenity of this highly valued local equestrian centre. The response of Enforcement to date appears inadequate for the scale of the problem.

The problem is urgent. Please advise as to what steps you will be taking.
